This Privacy Policy describes how Ghostly Solutions LLC-FZ ("Ghostly Solutions", "we", "our", or "us") collects, uses, discloses, and protects information when users ("you", "your") access or use our Software-as-a-Service (SaaS) platform for traffic filtering (cloaking), performance tracking, and analytics (the "Service").

1. Information We Collect

- 1.1 Account & Identity Information We may collect the following information when you create or manage an account: Name Email address Account login credentials Company or business **information (if provided) Billing and payment information (processed by third-party** providers; we do not store full payment card details)
- 1.2 Usage & Technical Information When you access or use the Service, we may automatically collect: IP address Browser type and version Device information Operating system Log

data and timestamps - Referring URLs - API usage records - Error logs and diagnostic data

- 1.3 Traffic & Tracking Data (Processed on Your Behalf) Our Service is designed for media buyers, affiliates and traffic experts to manage and analyze traffic. In this context, we may process, on your behalf: Visitor metadata (e.g., IP address, user agent, device type, language, and geolocation approximations) Clickstream and event data (e.g., page views, redirects, conversions) Tracking parameters and identifiers (e.g., UTM tags, affiliate IDs, campaign IDs, custom parameters) Rules, filters and cloaking configurations you define in the platform URLs and domain names connected to your account
- In respect of this traffic data, Ghostly Solutions generally acts as a data processor, processing data on your instructions as necessary to provide the Service.
- 1.4 Cookies & Similar Technologies We use cookies, pixels, and similar technologies to: -Authenticate users - Maintain sessions - Improve user experience - Analyze usage patterns -Enhance security and prevent fraud

You may control cookies through your browser settings, but certain features of the Service may not function properly if cookies are disabled.



2. How We Use Your Information

We use collected information for the following purposes:

- 2.1 To Provide and Operate the Service Create and manage user accounts Deliver traffic filtering (cloaking), tracking and analytics - Provide customer support and respond to inquiries
- 2.2 To Improve and Develop the Service Monitor and analyze usage Diagnose and fix technical issues Optimize performance and user interface Develop new features and functionality
- 2.3 To Communicate With You Send service-related notifications Provide onboarding, training and support Send updates about new features, maintenance, or policy changes Send marketing communications where permitted by law and where you have not opted out
- 2.4 For Billing and Financial Management Process subscription payments (via third-party payment providers) Conduct accounting and financial reporting Detect and prevent fraudulent transactions
- 2.5 Legal, Compliance & Protection Comply with applicable laws and regulations Respond to lawful requests from authorities Enforce our Terms of Service and other agreements Protect our rights, property and safety, and that of our users and third parties

3. Legal Basis for Processing (If Applicable)

Where data protection laws such as the GDPR apply, our legal bases for processing may include:

Performance of a contract (to provide the Service) - Our legitimate interests (e.g.,

certain marketing or optional features)

4. How We Share Information

We do not sell your personal information. We may share information with:

4.1 Service Providers We engage third-party vendors to help operate and support our Service, including: - Cloud hosting providers - Payment processors - Email and communication platforms - Analytics and monitoring tools

These providers only receive data necessary for their services and are contractually bound to appropriate confidentiality and data protection obligations.

- 4.2 Legal and Regulatory Authorities We may disclose information if required to do so by law or in response to valid legal requests, such as subpoenas or court orders.
- 4.3 Business Transfers If we are involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of assets, your information may be transferred as part of that transaction, subject to continued protection consistent with this Privacy Policy.



5. Data Retention

We retain personal data only as long as necessary for the purposes described in this Privacy Policy, including to: - Provide the Service - Comply with legal and regulatory obligations - Resolve disputes - Enforce agreements

You may request deletion of your account or specific data, subject to legal retention requirements.

6. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your information, including: - Encryption in transit (HTTPS/TLS) - Access controls and authentication - Secure storage of credentials - Monitoring for suspicious activity

However, no method of transmission or storage is completely secure, and we cannot guarantee

absolute security.

7. International Data Transfers

Your information may be processed in countries other than your own. We take reasonable steps to ensure that international data transfers comply with applicable data-protection laws and that appropriate safeguards are in place where required.

8. Your Rights
